Stop; hold it; stay there



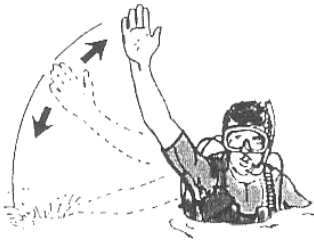
Something is wrong

OK? OK!



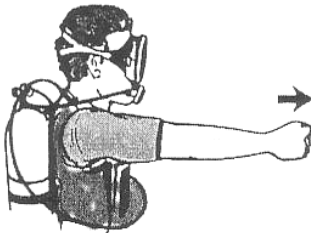
Distress; help!

Me or watch me



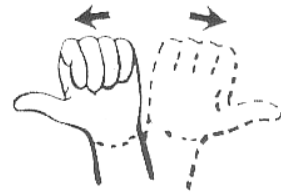
Under, over or around

Ears not clearing



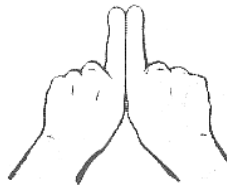
I am cold



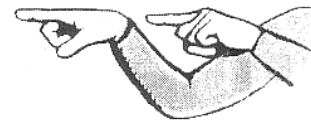
Take it easy; slow down
